



RANDWICK PARK SCHOOL

DRESS CODE / SCHOOL UNIFORM

RATIONALE:

Through consultation with the school's community, the Board of Trustees has decided that students attending Randwick Park School will wear a uniform.

PURPOSE:

1. To help develop a unified spirit and pride in our school.
2. To assist with ease of identification and promote a positive image of the school when out in the wider community.
3. To ensure the children are appropriately dressed for a range of school activities.

GUIDELINES:

1. The specified Randwick Park School uniform will be worn by all children to and from school, while attending school and when representing our school in the wider community.
2. Students are to present themselves in a clean and tidy manner at all times.
3. Where exceptions to the uniform are desired on a permanent basis, permission must be sought from the Principal in writing.
4. All children Year 3 and above are expected to wear the school's sports uniform when representing our school.
5. Student's safety is to be taken into account when considering appropriate footwear.

6. The school uniform is:

Summer

Term 1 and from Labour Weekend T4
and Collared Polo Shirt
Shorts
Sweatshirt
Skirt
All Students - School Sun Hat

Winter

Term 2 from Queen's Birthday weekend
up to Labour Weekend T4
Collared Polo Shirt
Sweatshirt
Navy Skivvy (optional)
Navy Scarf (optional)
Navy Beanie (optional)
Navy Shorts
Navy Polo Fleece
Navy Trackpants

Footwear:

Black or brown shoes, slip ons with backs or lace up OR sports shoes with plain white, navy or black socks OR black or brown sandals with an ankle strap.

Hair ties/headbands – navy or black.

Hair more than shoulder length is to be tied back.

Studs only to be worn - in each ear.

Rings, bracelets, nail polish etc are not part of our school uniform except in the case of Medical Alert items.

Cultural jewellery may be worn when an explanatory note is presented to the school and placed on record.

CONCLUSION:

We expect students attending Randwick Park School to have pride in belonging to our school and pride in the way they physically present themselves.
